ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

Telangana University is established through Act Number 28 of 2006, Government of Andhra Pradesh to cater to the academic pursuits of backward and rural student community belongs to Nizamabad and Adilabad districts. Due to the inadequacy of facilities for Higher Education in these two districts and inability of the existing universities to cater the needs of Post Graduate and Research Programmes in remote and inaccessible backward and tribal areas and with a view to remove the regional imbalances of Higher Education in Andhra Pradesh, the Telangana University was established at Dichpally of Nizamabad district. It is exactly located in a picturesque and greenery land about 577 acres at Dichpally. The University, at present is offering 24 Post Graduates courses where around 1500 students are pursuing their studies in various courses at University Main Campus, South-Campus of Bhiknoor and the college of Education at Sarangapoor. The class rooms are spacious, laboratories are well equipped and hostel accommodation is provided separately for Girls and Boys with play grounds within. All most all the courses are unique in nature and very professional and highly job oriented.

NIZAMABAD DISTRICT

Nizamabad is a town situated in the Telangana State. Nizamabad owns the Corporation Status. River Godavari passes through Nizamabad district. Nizamabad is located 165 KMs away from the Hyderabad, connecting to NH-44. Nizamabad is also connected by the train route from Bhuvaneshwar to Mumbai covering the places Vizag, Vijayawada, Warangal, Secunderabad, Nanded, Pune etc., Rajiv Gandhi International Airport, Shamshabad is the nearest Airport. For every 15 minutes we have a Bus facility between Hyderabad and Nizamabad as well as Warangal and Nizamabad. There is a Saraswathi temple at Basar on the bank of Godavari River which is the prominent holy temple in Asian Continent, 35 Kms away from Nizamabad.

DEPARTMENT OF APPLIED ECONOMICS

The Department of Applied Economics is established in the year 2007. It has been committed towards promoting High Quality Teaching, Research and Consultancy activities. It offers programmes of M.A (Economics) of 2 years and M.A (Applied Economics) of 5 years Integrated & Ph.D. In the face of demand for competent economists outstripping the supply, Telangana University stands among the most

sought after Economics Department in the State of Telangana. The faculty is highly qualified with research experience in order to provide excellent teaching in Economics at Under Graduate and Post Graduate level. ABOUT THE SEMINAR

Building a 'BangaruTelangana' the key challenge for the Telangana State was to overcome the legacy of deliberate neglect and to create an enabling political, social, and economic environment, which promotes investment, growth and human development. The formation of the State is a golden opportunity to undo many of the disoriented policies and to introduce reforms for a participatory, accountable, and development oriented governance structure. The vision of the present Government is not only to undo the past neglect, but also to build a 'Bangaru (Golden) Telangana', which is inclusive and forward-looking. Since formation of Telangana state June 2014, the Government of Telangana, has taken formidable steps to undo the historic wrongs meted out to the State by reorienting the existing policies and laying out a way forward for building a 'Bangaru Telangana'. The challenge for building 'Bangaru Telangana' was summed up in the following words of the Hon'ble Chief Minister Sri. - iii) Programmes targeting social welfare and inclusive growth.
