INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

The candidates are hereby informed that the left-over / vacancies / cancelled seats in LLB (3 years) and LLM of University College of Law, Telangana University Nizamabad will be filled through Institutional spot admissions held at the Law college, TU Campus. The candidates desirous to seek admission are informed to contact the Director, Directorate of Admissions, Telangana University, Nizamabad.

- The details of available vacancies are placed in the website www.telanganauniversity.ac.in.
- Candidates with out original certificates are not permitted for spot admissions.
- ➤ Candidate shall be present at the college with all original certificates for spot admissions certificate verification. After due verification, the original certificates shall be returned back to the candidate only after final ratification. The candidate has to submit two sets of photo copies of certificates, three passport size phots and original transfer certificate (T.C) at the college.
- ➤ Fee reimbursement is **not applicable** to the candidates admitted under Spot Admissions.
- ➤ **Hostel fecility is not there** for Spot Admission candidates.

A. Procedure for Spot Admissions:

- 1. Candidates interested in participating in spot admissions must attend in person at Telangana University on 17-12-2024 at 10.00AM.
- 2. Candidates are required to complete their registration offline at spot admission place by 12.30PM.
- 3. At the time of registration process, all original certificates should be submitted for verification.
- 4. Spot admissions will be made based on merit (rank) obtained in TG LAWCET-2024/ TG PGLCET-2024.
- **5.** Candidates who secure admission through spot admissions counseling must report to the college on the same day and pay the admission fee and tuition fee also. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of the admission, and the seat will be offered to the next candidate on the waiting list.
- 6. Candidates who have already secured a seat in regular or spot counseling and wish to transfer to university college through spot admissions counseling will only be allotted a new seat after canceling their previous admission.

C. EligibilityCriteria:

1. The candidate should be of Indian Nationality.

- 2. The candidate should satisfy the Local/Non-local status requirement as laid down in the regulations of admissions. (Ref. G.O. Ms. No 64 dated 26.05.2006 and G.O. Ms. No116 dated 07.08.2007 and its amendments).
- **3. 3-Year LL.B**: The Candidates for 3-year L.L.B. Course should have passed any Graduate Degree (10+2+3 pattern) of a recognized University or any other examination recognized as equivalent by the Universities concerned with 45% of aggregate marks for general category, 42% for BC Category and 40% for SC/ST. If any candidate secured less than 45%, 42% and 40% respectively in graduation as stated above, he should have secured same percentage or more on the aggregate in any Post Graduation or B.Ed.
- **4. LL.M:** Candidates should have passed LL.B/BL from a recognized University.

Note:-The candidates who have passed Degree examination by single sitting without undergoing three years course either through regular or private or correspondence and those who obtained the degree through open University directly without having any basic qualification are not eligible as per G.O. Ms No. 31 dated:18-03-2009.

Note:

- Candidates may refer to the G.O.Ms.No.64, Higher Education (UE.II) Department, Dated: 26.05.2006, G.O. Ms. No.116 dt: 07.08.2007 and other G.Os along with amendments if any for ascertaining their eligibility.
- The percentage of 44.5% and above in aggregate in graduation (10+2+3 Pattern)/ Intermediate Examination (with 10+2 pattern) in case of candidates belonging to general categories, 41.5% or above in aggregate in graduation (10+2+3 Pattern) in case of candidates belonging to BC category and 39.5% and above in aggregate in graduation(10+2+3 Pattern) in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST category will be considered as 45%, 42% and 40% of aggregate marks respectively for admission into LL.B 3 year course.
- The Hon'ble High Court of Telangana in Writ Appeal. No. 597 of 2020, W.P. Nos 37566 and 42680 of 2016 and W.P. No. 28822 of 2021 vide its judgement Dated: 28.12.2021 held that the **B.A. External Graduates** of Osmania University are noteligible for admissioninto 3 year L.L.B. course and further the Court held that any candidates with such degree who secured admission in L.L. B. course by virtue of Interim Orders of the High Court will not get a right in their favour. The candidates may read the above judgement for further details, before applying for entrance or admission.
- Who pursued education in Distance / Correspondence / Open study have to be submit Undertaking Affidavit by the candidate, in the format is available in the website: https://lawcetadm.tsche.ac.in.
- The BC candidates applying for the TGLAWCET-2024/ TG PGLCET-2024 shall invariably submit their BC certificate issued by the competent authority to support 42% of aggregate marks in the Graduation.
- The Bar Council of India (BCI) official website http://www.barcouncilofindia.org/ may be seen for the Legal EducationRules, 2008.

NOTE:

- The applicants who have obtained 10+2 or Graduation / Post graduation through open Universities without having any basic qualification are not eligible for admission in to LL.B Courses.
- a. The Bar Council of India (BCI) official website http://www.barcouncilofindia.org/ may be visited for the Legal Education Rules, 2008.
- b. Candidates possessing Degree or its equivalent Certificates other than those issued by the University Concerned in Telangana are required to submit the equivalency certificate from the

concerned University in the State of Telangana before granting admission.

- c. The dropout vacancies (Reported but discontinued) shall be allotted only to that respective category.
- d. Likewise, the not reported and cancelled seats shall be allotted to that respective category.
- e. If a particular candidate is not available for female in a specified category, that seat shall be converted to male for same category.
- f. Candidates who belong to other states, have completed their studies out side Telangana, and whose parents also belong to and reside in other states are not eligible for admission. Such candidates cannot be considered as Non-Local (NL) for admission to Telangana State. Even if admission is granted in violation of the issued guidelines, it will not be ratified.
- g. Furthermore, candidates admitted through institutional spot admissions should be aware that their admission is subject to ratification by the Convenor, TG LAWCET-2024/TG PGLCET-2024 Admissions. If a candidate's admission is not ratified due to certain technical reasons, he or she will have to forfeit the admission.
